School Article 4. Shall the voters of the School District approve the school board to expend \$3,560,688.00 which is the amount the school board has determined to be necessary for the ensuing fiscal year? The Charleston School District estimates that this proposed budget, if approved, will result in per pupil education spending of \$14,222, which is 2.98% higher than per pupil education spending in the current year.
